

Tuition Fees

Note: Students are enrolled in a Bradford College course, delivered by Kaplan Business School.

The schedule of annual fees \$AUD are as follows:

Payment Schedule

Students are enrolled in a Bradford College course delivered by Kaplan Business School, therefore, all fees are payable to Bradford College.

Tuition fees are payable in two instalments. All instalments are payable unless the student withdraws prior to dates specified in the refund policy. First instalment is 50% of the tuition fee payable on acceptance of the offer.

Second instalment is the remainder of the tuition fee – payable 30 days prior to the date of commencement of the second semester.

Students studying both Part 1 and Part 2 of the Diploma have two extra instalments in the second year, in addition to the instalments above. The third and fourth instalments are to be paid 30 days prior to the commencement of each semester and students will receive an invoice for each semester.

Students may also be required to purchase education materials, such as textbooks, equipment and personal items including stationery - payment of which remains the responsibility of the student.

Students studying part-time will pay fees for all unit(s) of study they are enrolled in for that semester and fees are due 30 days prior to the commencement of each semester.

FEE HELP is now available to eligible fee paying students enrolled in the Diploma of Commerce. Bradford College has been approved as a Higher Education Provider (HEP) under section 16-50(1)(b) of the Higher Education Support Act 2003 (HESA) enabling students enrolled in the Diploma of Commerce (delivered by Kaplan Business School) to apply for FEE-HELP.

International Students

Students from other countries studying in Australia are subject to Australian Government laws which regulate the conditions under which international students can study in this country.

International students must study full-time as a condition of their student visa.
