

Diploma of Commerce Entry Requirements

Academic Entry Requirements – Part 1

Part 1 of the Diploma is designed for students who have passed Australian year 11 or equivalent. If you enter from year 11 you will be required to study approximately two years to achieve the full Diploma. Passes may be accumulated over more than one year.

Entry Requirements by Country

Australia	Successful completion of Year 11 or equivalent
China	Successful completion of Senior Middle 2 (SM2) with 75% average
Hong Kong	Successful completion of Form 5 (HKCEE)
India	All Senior School Certificate - minimum average of 50% in 4 academic units of study
Indonesia	Completion of SMU 2
Korea	High School Leaving Certificate Year 2 with a 'D' grade average in 4 academic units of study
Malaysia	Successful completion of Form 5 (SPM) with a maximum of 24 points across 6 units of study or Senior Middle 2 (SM2) or UEC with a 70% average or equivalent
Singapore	Successful completion of Form 5 or Singapore 'O' Levels with passes in 3 units of study at 'B' level or equivalent
Thailand	Successful completion of Matayom 5 with GPA of 2.5
UAE	Tawjihi with 50% average in academic units of study
Vietnam	Successful completion of Year 11
All other Countries	Enquire at School

- Academic assessment is based on the grades a student achieves in individual subjects, as well as an aggregate grade.
- Only academic subjects are considered, not subjects such as religious studies, ethics, and physical education.
- Each applicant will be assessed individually. Students must be able to provide documentary evidence of sound school grades, academic qualifications and English language proficiency.
- English requirement for direct entry (international students): IELTS 5.5 or equivalent (no individual score less than 5.0) or equivalent.

Academic Entry Requirements – Part 2

Part 2 of the Diploma is designed for students who have passed Australian year 12 or equivalent. Part 2 will take one year of full-time study to complete. Passes may be accumulated over more than one year.

Entry Requirements by Country

Australia	Successful completion of Year 12 or equivalent
China	Successful completion of Senior Middle 3 (SM3) with 75% average
Hong Kong	1 'A' level pass and 2 'AS' level passes in the HKALE
India	Completion of the All India Senior School Certificate - with an average of 55%
Indonesia	Completion of SMU 3 with an average grade of 7.0 in 4 academic units of study
Korea	High School Leaving Certificate Year 3 with a 'C' grade average in 4 academic units of study
Malaysia	STPM 2 passes or Senior Middle 3 (SM3) passes of 70% or above in 4 academic units of study or equivalent
Singapore	2 passes in the Singapore 'A' levels
Thailand	Successful completion of Matayom 6 with GPA of 2.0
UAE	Tawjihi with 70% average in academic units of study
Vietnam	Successful completion of Year 12
All other Countries	Enquire at School

English Language Entry Requirements–International Students

You will need to have a minimum score on one of the following tests for direct entry into the Diploma:

- Academic IELTS overall band score of 5.5 (individual scores cannot be below 5.0)
- TOEFL (paper based) – 525
- TOEFL (computer based) – 195

In individual cases, the school may accept alternative evidence of an applicant's English language proficiency.

If you do not meet the English proficiency requirements for direct entry you will need to enrol in an English language preparation program prior to commencing the Diploma.
